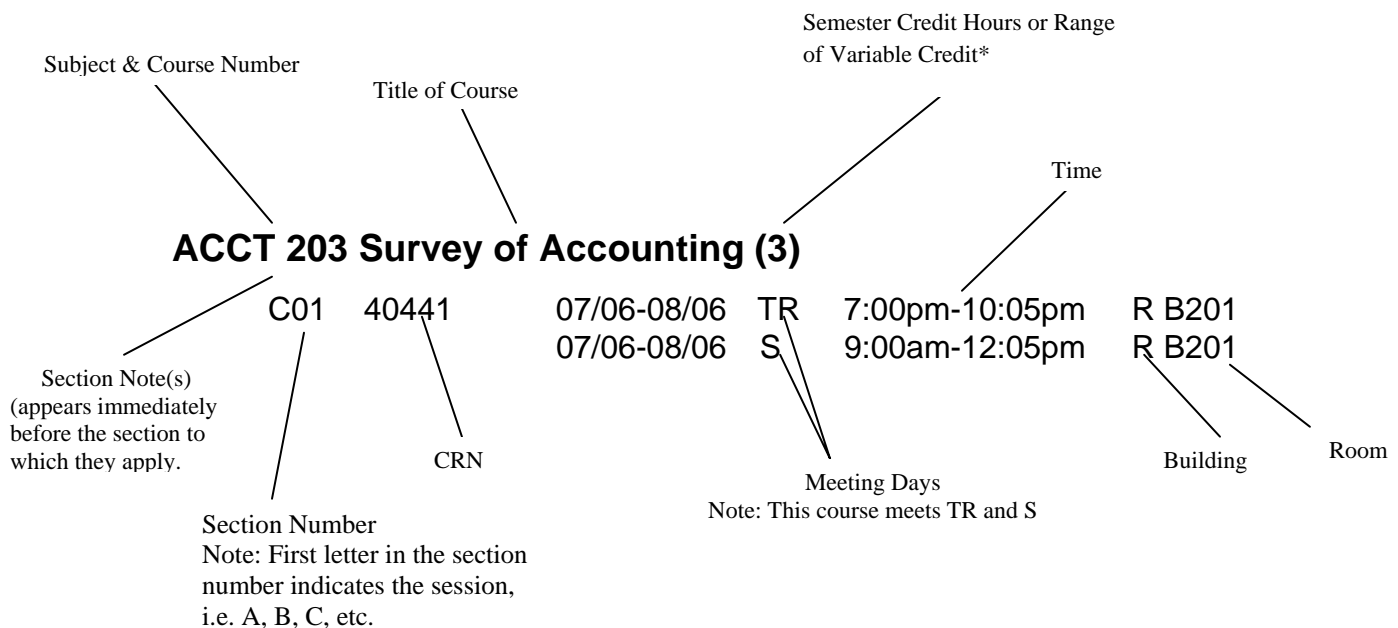


# 2009 SUMMER COURSE LISTING
